<b>MCAT</b>	Scores available online 30 to 35 days after the exam.	Scores are automatically released to AMCAS for tests taken after 2003. Scores can also be released electronically to non-AMCAS application service.	Test taker may void the exam at the end of the test period. Voided tests may not be “unvoiced” later. No refunds are given for voided tests.	Scores are retained by AMCAS indefinitely, though most medical schools only accept scores that are 2 to 3 years old.	5 scores (1 for each section & 1 total score); individual sections range from 118-132; total section ranges from 472-528.
<b>GMAT</b>	Scores may be received online or by mail 20 days after the exam. Unofficial scores are available immediately after the exam.	Send scores to up to five schools on the day the exam is taken. Additional score reports may be sent after the test for additional fees.	Test taker may cancel their exam only before viewing the unofficial scores. Cancelled exams will not be reinstated. No refunds are given for cancelled exams.	Scores are valid for 5 years. Scores from exams taken in the past 5 years will be sent to schools. Must submit a special request for scores more than 5 years old.	GMAT composite score range from 200 – 800. Analytical writing is scored on a 0 – 6 scale and is not part of the composite score.
